Owild Helligoth was born in Webcurra, Australia, in 1947 to Polish Jevish penents. As a leanager, David won the State finals of the ABC Instrumental and Vocal Competition etc limes, Issues Stern was so imprissed that he unped oversees study for the young prodigy.

Dancer/characterists and drummer Roland Cox is a long time colleague who joins us again for this concest with our own conga player Paul Solwick. Stephen and damie Goldsmith are also long time colleagues who featured in My Life, My Lova. We welcome Lyndon Grey who is performing with us for the first time this evening.

#### The Tutti Ensemble Holdfast Choir

This choir began as an initiative of Minda Inc In August 1997 with Pat Rix as leader. In four and a half years we have grown from a small group of 12 interfectually disabled people and two support workers at Minda enjoying choral singing as a recreational option, to a diverse group of over 70 singers and musicians. In the last two years, The Tutti Ensemble Holdfast Choir has become an international role model for community cultural development and promotion of diversity.

The philosophy of our choir is that there are no barriers to participation, therefore people with physical and intellectual disabilities and members of the community from widely differing age groups and musical experience are accepted and encouraged. Our repertoire has evolved to include gospel and popular songs as well as old fevourites and traditionals. We also sing songs from other cultures and original songs by contemporary writers.

The Choir is evallable for performences. Among the many community and conference presentations and performances we have done there have been many highlights. These include the Opening of The Festival of the Coast in January 2001, Channel 7 and The Advertiser Carols by Candlefight 2000, Robert Theobald's 'Heating Century' lecture at the Adelaide Town Hall In 1999, the 2001 Bartercard Jazz Festival at Glenelg and especially - opening Canada's KickstART Celebration of Disability Arts and Culture in Vancouver lest August 2001 with a song-cycle composed and conducted by Pat Rix.

But by for our most culturating achievement to date is the development and performance of Pat Rix's My

Life, My Love for State Theatre and the Adelaide Festival. This work was directed by the wonderful Rosethe Clemente, conducted by Ryszard Pusz and Phillip Griffin and performed with Brian Gilbertson, Jennifer Kneale, Barbare West and Stave Goldsmith together with many other outstanding actors, performers and musicians.
