About the Performers

The Tutti Choir - tutti means 'everyone' .

Pat Rix founded Tutti in 1997 as a small singing group for people with a disability. Since the beginning Tutti has pursued a national agenda, daring to dream, that universal access to rich choral performances for disabled and disadvantaged people will one day be the norm rather than the exception. Through ongoing high quality programs Tutti creates opportunities for everyone to shine, and over the years the Tutti Choir has performed at hundreds of concerts, major festivals and landmark public events - including Carols by Candlelight and WOMADelaide. Tutti has won many awards for original work and inspired the formation of sister choirs in SA, interstate and overseas as well as new ensembles within the organisation (Club Tutti, Poco Tutti and Hot Tutti). Since 2005 Tutti has expanded to create an award-winning Visual Arts and Digital Design program, a Performing Arts Program for disabled artists, and Tutti Kids - six age group specific music and drama programs for children living with disabilities.

In 2008 Tutti became a Key Producer with the Australia Council and today is widely recognised as a multi arts organisation. Tutti is delighted to have The Gathering Wave from Mount Barker, Heaven Knows Vocal Quartet and Cheryl Pickering as our special guests for the 2011 Christmas Concert.

The Gathering Wave - inspired by Tutti's inclusive choral model, The Gathering Wave is a choir for all comers based in Mt Barker as part of Ink Pot Arts Inc. We sing for fun and perform occasionally at small local events where we often receive an enthusiastic response. This year, we have been led by Pat Rix and, in 2009 had contact with Tutti singers Aimee Crather and Annika Hooper through a mentorship grant from the Richard Llewellyn Trust.
