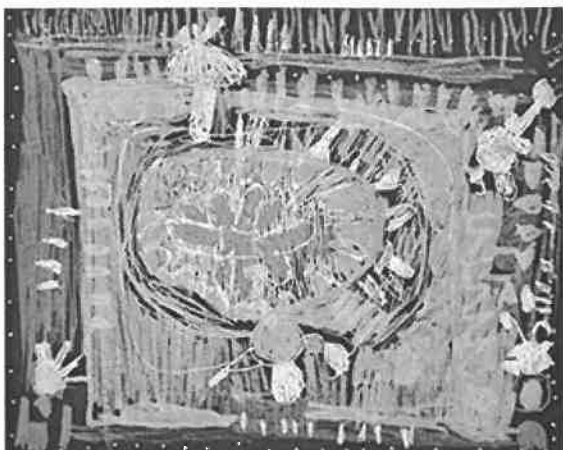

The 2016 Linden Postcard Show is an open entry exhibition for all artists from hobbyist, emerging to established, and celebrates its 26th



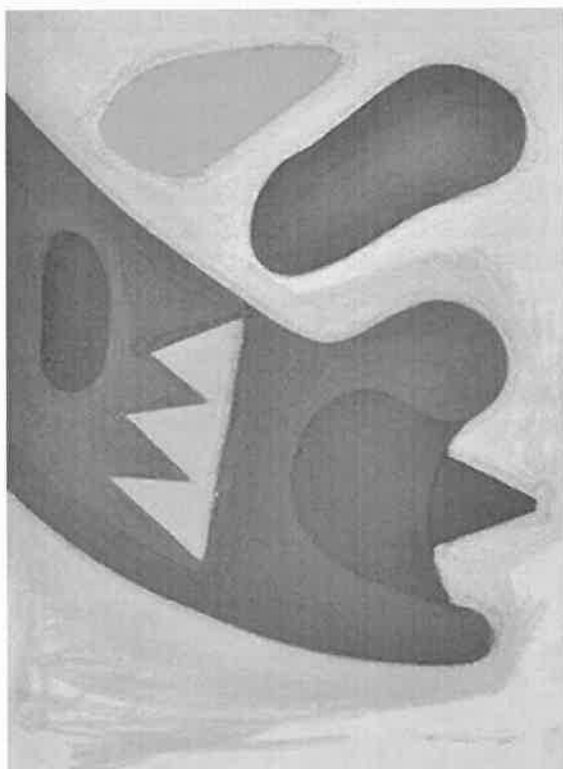

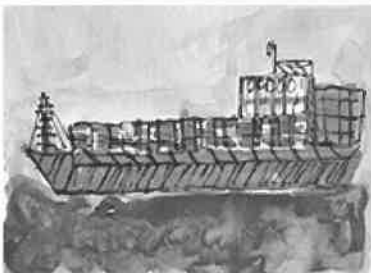
Paul Hodges, *Afternoon in the garden* 2014, acrylic on paper, 38 x 56 cm

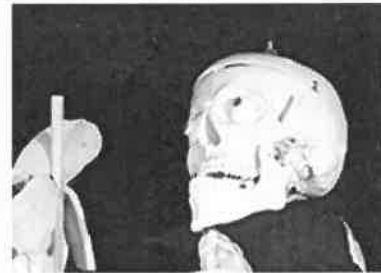
