Not all disabilities are obvious, some are hidden or invisible. For every person who has a visible disability, there are at least four who have an invisible disability. This can include autism, low vision, hearing loss, ADHD, MS and other chronic illnesses and lived experience of mental illness. This lack of recognition and understanding can lead to discrimination and judgements from others.
