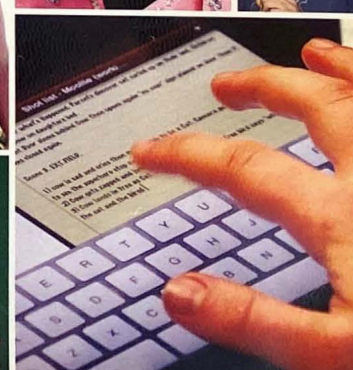
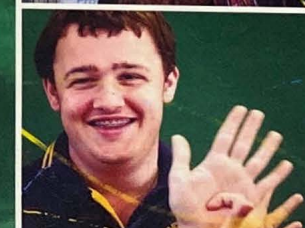
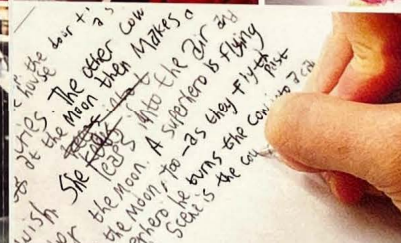
The **Sit Down Shutup & Watch** team is available to run film and new media workshops in your town or school.

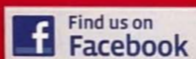
