Steven Ajzenberg accepted into the 2012 Paul Guest Prize. We are thrilled to announce Steven Ajzenberg has been selected into this year's Paul Guest Drawing Prize at Bendigo Art Gallery. Bendigo Art Gallery received over 300 entries Australia wide for this prize from which 45 artists were selected.

This exhibition showcases the work of contemporary artists and their current drawing practice and will award a single winner a \$12,000 cash prize. Bendigo Art Gallery Director Karen Quinlan said, "The works shortlisted have demonstrated extraordinary skill and aspiration."
