b - Performance or Presentation

To a maximum of five minutes Two \$400 prizes, one \$100 prize and two Certificates of Merit.

eligibility

The Awards are open to any person who has been resident in South Australia for a period of not less than one year prior to the closing date, who has a permanent disability and is eligible to be a client of Options Co-ordination.

guidelines for entry

- Original, unreleased entries can be in any style.
- Category a entries, ie: Composition, can be submitted on demo tape or in written form.
- Demo tapes must be no longer than five minutes.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a completed entry form.
- There is no entry fee.
- To maintain anonymity for judging purposes, the name of the entrant must only appear on the entry form.
- The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Any theme, any form Maximum of three poems, each no more than 50 lines Two \$400 prizes, one \$100 prize and two Certificates of Merit.

b - Prose

Any theme, to 3000 words Short story, passage from a novel or other prose form Two \$400 prizes, one \$100 prize and two Certificates of Merit.

eligibility

The Awards are open to any person who has been resident in South Australia for a period of not less than one year prior to the closing date, who has a permanent disability and is eligible to be a client of Options Co-ordination.
