

# DREAMBIG CHILDREN'S FESTIVAL AND TUTTI ARTS PRESENTS FROZEN GIRL

#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

All of us remember that time in early adolescence when having a best friend is everything. Similarly, every parent knows that one day the little child they are close to will grow and begin to separate from them. But what happens when a child separates so completely that even when with you they are unable to communicate or move.

Frozen Girl is Kathryn Evans story, first told in 2014 during storytelling workshops, when she revealed that between the ages of 11 and 13 she did not speak or move. Kathryn's story and the way she told it with her small intricate facial expressions and her unhurried physicality was so powerful that I and members of the ensemble wanted to explore it further with her.

The process of devising and developing this work with Kathryn and the ensemble with Julian Jaensch, Pat Rix, and support worker Annalise Donders has been deeply collaborative. In early 2016 we were joined by writer Emily Steel and designer Mawarini who worked with us on the realisation of the script and visual storytelling for Frozen Girl. More recently Sascha Budimski and Nic Mollison created sound and lighting to enhance this work which traverses the realms of fairy tale, memory and imagination to reveal Kathryn's emotional experience.

Medicine appears to find no organic cause for Conversion Disorder aka Frozen Syndrome, rather it is thought to be triggered by emotional distress or trauma. For Kathryn this was the loss of her only friend, and her fear of loneliness. Frozen Girl tells us that no matter how isolated or separate we feel, there is always hope and a time to reconnect.

If we're going to talk about the writing of *Frozen Girl*, here are some things you should know: That beautiful monologue the Brother has? That was improvised in rehearsal, one version by Joel and another by Lorcan, while I frantically scribbled them down.

The funny, surprising narrators? Juha invented them and suggested the things they might talk about, then I riffed on his ideas.

The wonderful thoughts that the doctors have about how to cure Kathryn? The cast sat round the lunch table and came up with those.

I could go on, but you get the point. The script has been very much a collaboration, starting with the real-life story from Kathryn and her family, and developing over months and months of workshops and rehearsals with Juha and the company. So much of the storytelling isn't spoken - it's in movement, images, sound - and most of my job has been trying to capture what was going on in the room and get it down on the page in something resembling the right order.

One of my favourite improvised lines - "Lucky ducky" - didn't make it into the final script. So I'll borrow it and use it here. I feel quite the lucky ducky to have been part of *Frozen Girl*. Thank you, everyone. **Emily Steel.**
