With half of its members identifying with a disability, the Tutti Choir has become an internationally acclaimed model of artistic excellence and social inclusion with a truly unique voice. Poco (little) Tutti is comprised of soloists and experienced singers from the large Tutti Choir. Poco Tutti has been the headline act at the 2016 Denmark Festival of Voice (WA) and the 2017 Desert Song Festival in Alice Springs. Poco Tutti also appeared in the State Theatre SA/Belvoir Street production of *The Events* in the 2016 Adelaide Festival of Arts and in Brink Production's *Memorial* in the 2018 Adelaide Festival.

Poco Tutti is rapidly gaining a national reputation as a choir that goes to heart of our humanity, our sense of community, and our souls.

About Tutti Arts Music Programs

Tutti's popular Wednesday Afternoon Music program focuses on voice, ensemble singing, and rhythmic, melodic and harmonic awareness.

The Friday Voice Specialist program is offered by invitation only and provides further development, including one-on-one sessions, for advanced singers. The program covers singing, solo performance, writing and creating.

Music programs on Monday offer instrumental and ensemble music playing and digital technology for sound design and composition for theatre and film.
