# The Tutti Choir - tutti means 'everyone'

Founded by Pat Rix in August 1997 as a small singing group of nine for people with a disability, the work of the Tutti Choir has had an impact far beyond South Australia. Tutti's mission is to create opportunities for everyone to shine, and since it incorporated in 2001 the choir has performed at hundreds of community events and conferences, at major festivals and landmark public events including Carols by Candlelight and WOMADelaide. In 2008 the Tutti Choir won top honours in the Australian 'Music in Communities Awards' for bringing disadvantaged people together through music. From the very beginning Tutti has pursued a national agenda and dared to dream that one day universal access to rich choral performances for disabled and disadvantaged people will be the norm rather than the exception. This philosophy has now been expanded to include all the arts and Tutti is also home to an award-winning Visual Arts and Digital Design program, a broad Performing Arts program for disabled artists, and six age group specific Tutti Kids Music and Drama programs for children living with disabilities.

## The Holdfast Bay Concert Band

The band was first formed in 1983 as the Brighton Concert Band and has worked under some very talented musical directors, competing in the National Band Championships and coming first in B Grade for 3 consecutive years, from 1991-1993. Due to the amalgamation of the Brighton and Glenela Councils, the band was renamed the City of Holdfast Bay Concert Band in January 1997. The band is a community band supported by revenue from concerts, fundraising activities, members, subscriptions, the Lions Club of Brighton and the City of Holdfast Bay Council Tonight is our first Christmas Concert with Tutti although this is the third time we have combined to present an exciting range of music.
