The project involved 2 curved concrete seating benches being covered with mosaic flowers, local fauna e.g., witchetty grubs, parrots, hawks and other flora and fauna representing Central Australia.

Local Artist Philomena Hali, worked on the project as the Project Officer and Artist/Mentor. Working alongside Philomena was Sue Codee, Guest Artist and Mentor, from Albany, W.A. Together they guided & assisted participants with this creative process.

This community mosaic bench project is part of ArtsACA's revised 2008 Program, comprising two specific artform projects, involving participants from the Disability Organisations represented by Arts ACA as well as other Organisations we network with.
