To create this unique work over 60 women from Malaysia, Indonesia and Australia, of all ages with and without disabilities came together in mid 2017 to talk about what is happening for them as women now. The stories shared by women in all three countries shared the common themes of family, marriage and women's relationship to the state. This informed the conceit of the wedding reception as a setting for the theatre work, and also became a starting point for the films and art installations that grew from the later workshops.

This project was always intended to build bridges between professional artists and organisations seeking to develop the skills and talent of young disabled women with a strong interest in the arts. The deeply collaborative process has enabled women to work side by side to create art and to rehearse a new work which is truly owned by the cast. We hope the new relationships the process has generated will be ongoing and continue to strengthen the voices of disabled and other marginalized women in our countries.

Since the first workshops in July 2017, sixteen Malaysian women from Stepping Stone, ten Indonesian artists and fifteen Australian artists have contributed to the development of Say No More. The resulting performances, films and artworks invite us to question a world where so many cultural institutions are man-made rather than woman-made, and to think about how society still engineers gender, and how and why disability and difference are so often feared or perceived as 'less than'.
