

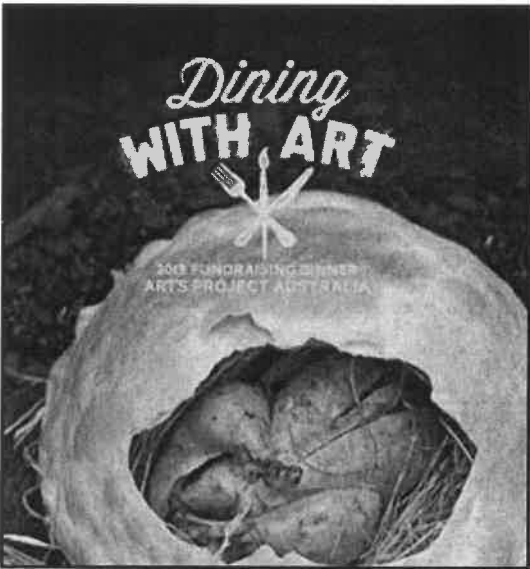

It is with regret we announce that Jonah Jones has recently stepped down from the Board of Arts Project Australia. Jonah has been a supporter of Arts Project Australia for over two

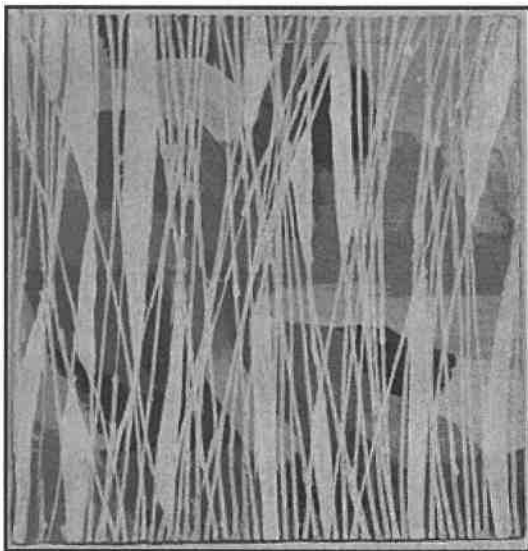


Catherine Easton and Jonah Jones

Bobby Kyriakopoulos

Bobby Kyriakopoulos uses the whole of the picture plane to accentuate the positive and negative spaces between image and ground. A skilled draughtsman, he meticulously applies watercolour or gouache with strokes which are quite deliberate yet still retain a gestural quality. Kyriakoulos has been attending Arts Project Australia since 2011. He currently has a work on display in the 2013 *Linden Postcard Show* at Linden Centre of Contemporary Arts and will have work in the upcoming exhibition *At the Table*.
