Barbara McGuire is an Australian born artist. After a career in teaching she was able to develop and extend her long held interest and knowledge in

art. She has developed both a traditional and a creative approach in her paintingsusing watercolours, oils, acrylics, pastels and mixed media. Barbara has won several awards and has had three solo exhibitions. Her work has been exhibited in many regional exhibitions as well as at the Adelaide Art Society and the Royal South Australian Society of Arts. Barbara is a Fellow of the Royal South Australian Society of Arts. She is also a member and former president of the Adelaide Art Society. She is a member of the Australian Guild of Realist Artists, The South Australian Water Colour Society, the Pastel Artists of South Australia, the Port Community Art Society and the Friends SASA.

Jack Condous was born in Adelaide from Greek parents who migrated to Adelaide, Australia in 1928. Jack studied as an art teacher at the South Australian School of

Art (SASA) and Adelaide Teachers College. He was awarded a Fulbright teacher exchange in August 1968 to Milford, Mass USA and completed his Masters Degree in 1970 - returning to Adelaide he was appointed to an administrative position assisting in the supervision of over 500 Art Teachers throughout SA.

He became World President of the International Society for Education Through Art in 1978 and travelled to 28 countries during his 3 year term of office.

He is on the Council of RSASA and joined as a Board member of Tutti in August 2012. He has had a number of group shows in SA and interstate.

In 2010 he held a very successful solo show on his parents' Island of Kastellorizo. He has since exhibited at the RSASA, Adelaide Art Society and a number of Friends exhibitions.

#### Lot 5 Lois Turner "Reveries of a solitary walker" Mixed media collage Acrylic and oil painting My paintings refer to the multiple rhythms produced

through the daily habit of walking. Rhythm has been a defining feature of my work

throughout my career. From my work's humble beginnings, rhythm had more to do with the formal elements of painting: repetition of objects, shapes, space, lines, light or direction of movement. More recently, my understanding of rhythm has developed into an intriguing analysis of biological rhythms in everyday life: cosmic rhythms, day and night, months, seasons, and their impact on non human and human bodily rhythms such as breathing, heart beat and biological clocks.

"Reveries of a solitary walker" incorporates musical rhythm in relation to the body, to time and to everyday life.

Hugh Adamson is an Australian born artist and former teacher of art to secondary students. Presently he runs a small business in Warradale producing graphics for the real estate industry plus digital imaging for industry and individuals. He works and has worked on several themes: commissioned portraits, a musician series, a dance series, a 'dogs on the beach' series and has had some success with landscapes lately, particularly with his 2012 Waterhouse Exhibition finalist 'Hay Plain Dawn'.
