





Satellite is a masterclass studio for artists with disability run by Arts Access Victoria in partnership with the Monash Gallery of Art.

An intensive, masterclass environment provides emerging artists with the opportunity to work closely with two experienced practising artists, refining their artistic practice.

Satellite artists work on projects that are designed to grow their individual practice while working in a professional group studio setting.

Drawing, photography, animation and filmmaking are offered throughout the program.

The Satellite studio is located at the Monash Gallery of Art, Wheelers Hill, Thursdays 9:30am-3:30pm.




