This report combines a list of grants made during the 1974/75 financial year with a summary account of the Council's activities between January and June 1975. It also contains the financial statement covering the period between March 13, 1975 — the date on which the Australia Council Act was proclaimed — and June 30, 1975.

Previously, as the Australian Council for the Arts, the Council reported on a calendar year basis: its last annual report was for the year 1974. This publication effects a change to what in future will be financial year reporting both in terms of financial statements by the Council and of the state of the arts in Australia.

Details of Council activities in this report are necessarily restricted because they were covered by or foreshadowed in the report for the 1974 calendar year.

Under its charter to assist the broad development of Australian artistic life, the Council's programs of support for arts

organisations and projects in the different art forms have continued, as has the sponsorship of community participation in arts activity.

The Council also has continued to engage in activities beyond grant-giving. Between January and June 1975 it

- began a co-operative scheme with the Department of Tourism and Recreation for capital grants against funds totalling \$2 million available for commitment in 1974/75.
- initiated a national critics' award scheme to be administered by critics of the arts with a view to raising professional standards by critical evaluation.
- established a visual arts studio in New York for use by visiting Australian artists.
- instigated the establishment (by the Federal Attorney-General's Department) of a working committee to examine existing copyright legislation to consider the need

for new legislation specifically designed to protect Aboriginal individual and overall rights to their own heritage of arts.

received the Prime Minister's endorsement of a proposal to develop a scheme for the allocation of a small proportion of the total cost of public buildings to be set aside for art works.

The Council also began negotiations with the Australian Broadcasting Commission for a visit by the orchestra of the Shanghai Philharmonic Society under the China-Australia cultural exchange package for 1975. The package also included an Australian exhibition of Chinese crafts, a visit to China by the Rosny Children's Choir from Tasmania and an exhibition in Peking of Australian landscapes.

The Australia Council Act requires that all membership appointments to the Council and Boards should be for terms of not less than one and not more than three years. To avoid too great a disruption of membership at the time when the Act came into force, the then Prime

Minister re-appointed members as follows:

- Members retiring on 30 June 1975 were re-appointed to 30 June 1976;
- Those due to retire on 30 June 1976 were re-appointed to 31 December 1976;
- Those due to retire on 30 June 1977 were re-appointed to that date.

The 1974/75 list of grants which follows this summary account of the Council's activities in the last half of that year illustrates the tremendous diversity of artistic endeavour and achievement supported and encouraged by government funding and the way in which the arts are weaving deep into the social fibre of Australia.

Australia has come far since the first official gesture of support from government to the arts when Governor Macquarie in 1818 gave Michael Massey Robinson two government cows for his services to poetry, but we still have a long way to go.

Notes to and forming part of the accounts for the period ended 30 June 1975

Statement of Assets and Liabilities

1. Cash at bank and on hand includes an imprest advance \$600 appropriated by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet during the period ending 13 March 1975. Formal approval has been sought to have this amount transferred to the Australia Council.
2. Fixed Assets
Furniture and equipment, library and musical instruments are shown in the Statement of Assets and Liabilities at cost. Works of art are shown at valuation.
Assets amounting to \$229,629 were purchased by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet to 30 June 1975. Formal approval has been sought to have these assets transferred to the Australia Council.
In accordance with Treasury policy in relation to non-trading statutory authorities, no provision has been made for depreciation. Funds for replacements will be provided from Parliamentary Appropriations as the need arises.

3. Parliamentary Appropriations

The Statement of Income and Expenditure is for the period from 13 March 1975 to 30 June 1975.

The amount of \$97,900 was appropriated to the Australia Council under Appropriation Act (No. 5) 1974-75 and was received by the Council on 12 June 1975. Expenditure against this appropriation was incurred during the period 13 June 1975-30 June 1975.

The Australia Council Act 1975 was assented to on 13 March 1975 and expenditure continued to be undertaken by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet on behalf of the Council for the period 13 March 1975 to 30 June 1975, as follows:
