For fifteen years the Tutti Choir has been a passionate force for change through the creation of extraordinary art which surprises, entertains and reveals a different world view. Since 2001, the collaborative relationship between singers with a disability, singers from the wider community and professional composer/conductors has supported the development of several award winning music theatre works and led to exhilarating performances here and overseas. It has also led to the formation of three choirs who are all performing this afternoon; the original Tutti Choir of up to 70 singers, Poco Tutti, a small choir for advanced singers, and Club Tutti, for those who enjoy social singing. Our organisation also supports choirs based on the original Tutti model and this afternoon the Gathering Wave Choir from Inkpot Arts, Mount Barker is delighted to be sharing their version of Silent Night with us.

Since 2004 Tutti has offered professionally led programs in the visual, performing and digital arts to disabled artists. Artists in these programs have won significant awards and grants, and increasingly are being recognised by the professional arts world here and overseas.

More recently, the all-girl Alt-pop group Hot Tutti won recognition in their own right through the Australian Human Rights Commission documentary "Twenty Years, Twenty Stories" to be launched in Sydney next March. We congratulate Hot Tutti and their Musical Director, Michael Ross on this notable achievement. We thank Richard and Laura and all in Tutti who have worked so hard to prepare this afternoon's 15th Anniversary Concert which both celebrates Tutti as a growing and vibrant arts community and delights in the richness and beauty of human voice. Richard Chew - Musical Director

Richard is a composer, conductor and educator whose works include operas, several large-scale works for orchestra and chorus for the English National Opera, Welsh National Opera and many others. His work also includes music for theatre and film and he has devised several new works for children and people with disability. Richard's music has been performed and broadcast widely in the UK, Europe, Australia and the USA. Recent productions include *The Velvet Gentleman* (2012 Adelaide Cabaret Festival), *Instructions for an Imaginary Man* (2012 Adelaide Festival), *The Magic Flute* (2011 Tutti & State Opera) and *Stari Most* (2011 Come Out Festival). Richard is Musical Director of Choral Works and lectures in Music at Uni SA.

Laura Ellis - Resident Conductor

Laura is an Adelaide based singer/songwriter and accomplished performer with nearly ten years' experience performing original works. Laura currently teaches piano at various Adelaide Hills Primary Schools, is the Conductor of Poco Tutti Choir and Assistant to Richard with the Tutti choir.
