Creative Arts Program (North & West)

The **Arts Access H&CS Creative Arts Program** creates artistic opportunities for adults registered with Intellectual Disability Services (IDS) in the Northern and Western regions served by Health & Community Services.

The **Creative Arts Program** includes workshops in the visual and performing arts, run in four, eleven week terms throughout the year.

Visual arts activities include painting, printmaking, drawing, mask making and ceramics. Performing arts activities include music movement, dance and drama.

The program aims to stimulate and develop the creativity and artistic expression of each participant with exciting activities that focus on accessibility and fun!

For placement in the program, simply complete the application form and send it to Arts Access for approval. Fees have been introduced for workshops and projects run under the program. These are listed below. All fees are to be paid either in advance of, or on the first day of a workshop's term.

As Arts Access wishes to provide a developmental program, participants are expected to maintain regular attendance (with allowances for illness or occasional conflicting appointments). Placement in the program is negotiated on a term to term basis, with priority given to continuing members.

Arts Access is a non-profit organisation committed to creating opportunities in the arts with people with disabilities and people disadvantaged by social conditions.
