The program operates 3 full days each week throughout the year, with artists participating in 2D, 3D and digital-media projects (through Tutti’s Digitech Program). Lead by a team of professional arts-workers, supported by volunteers and placement students, the artists work to develop their individual interest areas, styles and technical skills.

The Tutti visual artists participate regularly in exhibitions, as a group and individually.
