### **Tutti means 'Everyone'**

Begun as a small inclusive choir by Pat Rix in 1997, Tutti has grown into a multi-level arts organisation whose pioneering work in radical inclusion is legendary. Tutti is about building bridges in the community through the visual and performing arts and the Tutti Choir in particular celebrates the power of music to overcome isolation created by disability, age or race. In December 2007 Tutti was designated one of eleven Key Producer companies with the Australia Council and in 2008 won the Music Council of Australia's National Music in Communities Award.

With a string of notable productions to its credit, Tutti is recognised as an outstanding model of artistic excellence and social inclusion in Australia and overseas.

As such the Tutti Choir has been invited to perform at WOMAdelaide 2010. Tonight, the Tutti Choir and Poco Tutti will be led by Music Directors Philip Griffin and Jonathan Bligh.

### **Gathering Wave**

Inspired by Tutti's inclusive choral model, The Gathering Wave choir began in Mt Barker in 2006 as part of Ink Pot Arts Inc, a not for profit community arts organisation based in the Adelaide Hills.

Our vision embraces the power of the Arts to transform lives and enhance the cultural life of community.

Since September 2009 the choir has been mentored by Tutti, supported by T Richard Llewellyn Arts & Disability Trust, the District Council of Mt Barker and Janesce.

Led by Beverley Sharrad-Jones, the choir has chosen to sing Van Morrison's *Joyous Sound* in memory of Andy Sutherland, a member of the choir and founding member of 'Trees for Life' who recently passed away.

### **Unley Concert Band: Music Director – Dr Kevin Cameron**

Led by noted conductor and educator Dr Kevin Cameron, the award winning Unley Concert Band has been part of the musical life of South Australia since 1997.

The band focuses on a wide range of quality, symphonic music for wind band and performs a broad and entertaining repertoire for community concerts and events.

In 2009 these have included the Australia Day Lunch, Credit Union Christmas Pageant and many others.

Earlier this year the band toured Europe in 2009 between Easter and Anzac Day to participate in commemorative services in France and Belgium.
