Tutti Kids is a music and drama program for children living with disabilities and their siblings.

Children aged between 2 and 15 years have the opportunity for making music, exploring movement, singing, imaginary play and unlocking their creativity, in a supportive and encouraging environment.

The program develops literacy, numeracy, social and listening skills, giving children the opportunity to enjoy themselves as they build personal confidence, self-esteem and discover their creative potential.

Participants in the workshop program also have the opportunity to perform in a range of exciting community and main-stage events through the Tutti Ensemble's various activities.

## About the classes

Small classes are led by specialist music and drama tutors who have extensive experience in working with children with special needs.

Each class aims to meet the needs of participating children, enhancing their learning and creativity through individual programming.

One hour sessions are held weekly during each school term. Currently, classes are offered at Lower Mitcham, Christies Beach, Brighton and Parafield Gardens.
