experience the wonderful world of the mask.

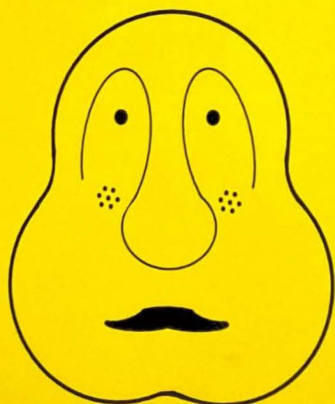
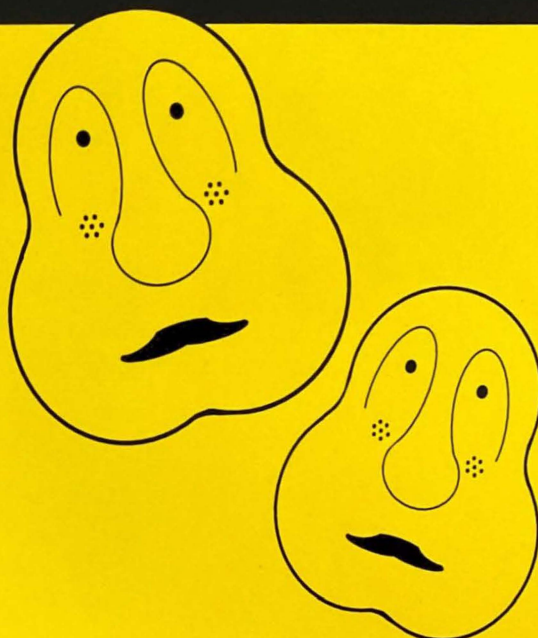
The charm, humour and naivety of our masked
