The Cigar Box Exhibition takes its inspiration and theme from the provocative Impressionist "Nine by Five Exhibition" of 1889. Instigated by Tom Roberts, Charles Conder, Frederick McCubben & Arthur Streeton, this exhibition initiated dialogue and inquiry within the arts community. Painted on cigar box lids the affordable size of the works made them indispensable decorative accessories and these works were purchased by a broad cross section of society.

In the Cigar Box Exhibition, recognised and emerging artists come together to present works on panels reminiscent of cigar box lids. Many of the artists have a disability. The exhibition inspires the sense of two parties seeking a common ground and working towards mutual understanding. As with the Nine by Five Exhibition, "Cigar Box" challenges established norms and inspires new approaches. Both arouse an excited sense of anticipated directions. Streeton reviewed the Nine by Five Exhibition as a major turning point for Australia's arts community. Accessible Arts developed the Cigar Box Exhibition and **Arts Extraordinaire** to encourage a turn towards action on key issues relating to arts and disability.

Arts Extraordinaire will be held at The Powerhouse Museum, The ABC Centre Ultimo, State Library of NSW, University of Technology Sydney and Bondi Pavilion Community Cultural Centre.

Arts Extraordinaire will run from November 1 to 10.
